### **Day 1 – Istanbul - Bursa**

Welcome to Turkey!! You will be met at Istanbul Airport and transferred to Bursa hotel by ferry (by private car). It takes approximately 3 hours to travel between Istanbul Airport and the hotel in Bursa. Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 2 – Bursa**

After breakfast, we start our tour to explore Bursa. We will visit the Grand Mosque, Green Mosque & Tomb, Kozahan and Grand Bazaar. Lunch at a local restaurant. After the tour, drop off the hotel and overnight in Bursa.

### **Day 3 – Bursa**

After breakfast, free time for leisure activities and shopping. Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 4 – Bursa - Istanbul**

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and we pick you up and transfer to Istanbul by ferry (by private car). After arrival, check in to the hotel; free time for leisure activities and shopping. Overnight at the hotel

### **Day 5 – Princess Island Tour**

Cruise on the Marmara Sea and sail to Heybeliada. After disembarking, embark on a horse carriage tour and soon after, we take a ferry and sail to the biggest island, Büyükada, where we will take lunch and enjoy free time. Return to Istanbul by ferry and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

### **Day 6 – Istanbul**

After breakfast, free time for leisure activities and shopping. We can offer a selection of tours as follows should time allow prior to your onward flight.

- Bosphorus by boat: An amazing cruise between the two continents, Europe and Asia, along the Bosphorus by Dolmabahce Palace and Beylerbeyi Palace.
- The Rumeli Fortress (from the sea): The castle was built by Mehmet II to prevent the Byzantine fleet, which had control of the Bosphorus, from communicating with its northern allies.



- Cable Car & Pierre Loti Hill: Hill was named by the French author of the famous novel "Aziyade". It is said that Aziyade was the name of an Ottoman woman who Pierre fell in love with. The name of the hill was given by him because of his support to the Ottoman Empire.
- Cable Car: Ride from the top of the hill to the Golden Horn.
- Golden Horn (by bus): As a natural and secure harbour, the Golden Horn has played an important role in the development of Istanbul. The inlet separates the European shore into two.

Check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport for your onward journey.
