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Day 1 – Istanbul - Sapanca

Welcome to Turkey!! You will be met at Istanbul Airport and transferred to your hotel in Sapanca. Overnight.

Day 2 – Sapanca & Masukiye Entertainment Tour

After breakfast, proceed to the Sapanca & Masukiye Entertainment Tour. Sapanca lake will be the second stop whose area is 42km². You can have a walk along the lakeside or pedalling on the lake with a nice lake view. Then, we will drive to Maşukiye Village to have lunch consisting of organic foods. Next, we will see Maşukiye waterfall. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 3 – Sapanca - Bursa

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to your hotel in Bursa. Overnight.

Day 4 – Bursa

After breakfast, we will explore Bursa city and Uludag. Firstly, we will visit the Grand Mosque, Grand Bazaar and Tophane. Afterward, take a cable car to reach Uludag. Enjoy a barbeque lunch in the open air. Return back to your hotel by cable car. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 5 – Bursa - Istanbul

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer by ferry to your hotel in Istanbul. Overnight.

Day 6 – Istanbul - Two Continents & Bosphorus Full Day Tour with lunch

After breakfast, discover the best of Istanbul on a full-day tour that covers the city by land and boat. You'll also enjoy a relaxing sightseeing cruise on the Bosphorus River and cross the Bosphorus Bridge, which links the continents of Europe and Asia.

Tours include:

City Walls: The first breach of the walls was by the Fourth Crusade in 1204, the second by the cannons and troops of Sultan Mehmet the Conqueror in 1453.

Golden Horn: As a natural and extremely secure harbor, the Golden Horn has played an important role in the development of Istanbul. The inlet separates the European shore into two. It is approximately 8 km long, and the widest part is the entrance from the Bosphorus. Two streams drain into this inlet at its far end.

Spice Bazaar (Egyptian Bazaar): The air here is filled with the enticing aromas of cinnamon, caraway, saffron, mint, thyme and every other conceivable herb and spice.

Boat trip on the Bosphorus: An amazing cruise between the two continents, Europe and Asia, along the Bosphorus by the Dolmabahçe and Beylerbeyi Palaces, wooden villas and mansions up to the Rumeli Fortress.

The Rumeli Fortress (from the Sea) - No interior visit: Istanbul had been besieged many times before Mehmet the Conqueror took the city in 1453, but it managed to defend itself with the help of the Roman city walls.

Camlica Hill: One of the highest points in Istanbul. From the top, you can rest and admire the magnificent panorama of Istanbul and look out over the Bosphorus from the beautiful gardens, landscapes in traditional style also envisioned during the tours.

'Lunch with a view', on Camlica Hill.

Shopping: Turkey is one of the best leather producing countries in the world. We will watch a fashion-show in an outlet center which produces and manufactures different varieties of great quality leatherware.

Bosphorus Bridge: Step from one continent (Asia) to another (Europe). Passing the bridge by our vehicle.

Beylerbeyi Palace: The summer residence of Ottoman Sultans with its original furniture and magnificent gardens with the Harem on the Asian side.

Day 7 – Istanbul

After breakfast, free time for leisure activities and shopping. Overnight at the hotel
